

MODIFICATIONS TO THE LICENCE

- (A) The President of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka in his capacity as Minister in the exercise of the powers conferred on him by the Sri Lanka Telecommunications Act, No. 25 of 1991 as amended by the Act. No. 27 of 1996 (hereinafter referred to as the "Act") and all other powers exercisable by him for that purpose, granted on the 12th April 2017 to Bharti Airtel Lanka (Pvt) Ltd ("the Operator") a licence (the "Licence"), for the period specified in paragraph 2 of the Licence, to operate a telecommunication system (hereinafter referred to as the "Licensed System") of the Licence, with authority to do all or any of the acts specified in Schedule 2 subject to the conditions set out in Schedule 3 and revocation in Schedule 4 thereto. (hereinafter referred to as the "original Licence")
- (B) In accordance with Section 18 (1) of the Act, the Telecommunications Regulatory Commission of Sri Lanka (hereinafter referred to as the Commission) hereby effect the modifications to the Original Licence which are set out in the Schedule below, such modifications having been recommended by the Commission to the President and Minister of Technology of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka under section 18 (1) of the Act, and concurred to by the President in his capacity as Minister.

SCHEDULE

Sub Condition 6.2 of Schedule 3 shall be amended as follows.

- 6.2 The Licensed system shall include an Equipment Identification Register (EIR) that is used to verify and identify the individual mobile terminals. Licensed Operator shall be obliged to implement an EIR and the operator to ensure that only legally imported mobile phones and International Mobile Equipment Identity (IMEI) enabled devices are permitted to be activated in the networks of the Licensed System. The Commission shall publish the Standard Operational Procedure (SOP) in this regard and Operator shall strictly adhere to the said SOP.
